

Mobile Devices During Non-Instructional Time

Non-instructional Time at School: Time during the school day when students are not scheduled to be with a teacher. This includes immediately before and after school, breaks, lunchtime as well as during extracurricular events. This administrative procedure does not apply when students are at home.

Elementary Students (K-6)

- Students may not use personal mobile devices during non-instructional time.
- Exceptions include the use of personal mobile devices for health or medical reasons or to support special learning needs. To coordinate this exception, parents shall make the request to the school principal. This information will be documented in the student's Individual Support Plan or Medical Plan.

Junior/Senior High Students (Gr. 7 -12)

- Students are permitted to use personal mobile devices during non-instructional times. Student use must comply with [CTR's Student Conduct and Discipline Process](#).
